Coaches who take the time to plan and organise their trainings are more likely to achieve their goals and objectives.

Leader

It is important for all coaches to display positive leadership. It is the coach that players will to in moments of crisis. As leaders, coaches set the agenda, determine priorities and provide a direction.

Teacher

A coach must be able to share information and ideas. Players are very similar to students in that they are always seeking to new information to continually improve their game.

Successful applicants must agree to fulfil the following criteria:
